Theatre Requirements

John J. Conklin is a new theatre with state of the art sound and light systems. Please list your requirements. Our stage manager will contact you if there are any perceived problems.

Lighting - The lights will be run from a booth at the back of the auditorium. There will be a technician to program and run the cues. The stage will have a neutral front and side wash with 2 colours of back light and 2 gobo washes. 2 computer positional spotlights are also available.

Sound – Sound effects are run via Qlab with 6 separate fixed speaker positions. All sound effects should be provided in wav format on a thumb drive or as a fully built Qlab 3 workspace. There are also 2 CD players if needed. Actor amplification is not provided. If anyone is using live music and needs wired microphones or DIs, it takes extra time to run those items through the board. With enough warning it can be accomplished but not quickly or at the last minute. Same with a stage monitor.

Set & Props Requirements

Please advise what set pieces and props you will require. We will try to accommodate requests for furniture and so on but make no guarantees.

Please send **two marked play scripts indicating the sound and light cues**. We prefer that your technical person assist our lights and sound crew during the performance.
